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What are the components of a base station?

Power Supply: The power source provides the electrical energy to base station elements. It often features auxiliary power supply mechanisms that guarantee operation in case of lost or interrupted electricity, during blackouts. **Baseband Processor:** The baseband processor is responsible for the processing of the digital signals.

What are the components of a base station CB system?

Remember, the longer the CB antenna, the more potential range that you will have. The basic components for a Base Station CB System include a CB radio, power supply (if you are using a mobile CB radio instead of a base station CB radio), coax, and an antenna.

How much power does a base station have?

Maximum base station power is limited to 38 dBm output power for Medium-Range base stations, 24 dBm output power for Local Area base stations, and to 20 dBm for Home base stations. This power is defined per antenna and carrier, except for home base stations, where the power over all antennas (up to four) is counted.

What is a base station power system?

The base station power system serves as a continuous “blood supply pump station,” responsible for AC/DC conversion, filtering, voltage stabilization, and backup power. Its purpose is to ensure the uninterrupted operation of base station equipment.
