Power banks with a capacity of up to 100 watt-hours (Wh), roughly 27,000 milliampere-hours (mAh), are allowed in carry-on baggage only. For batteries between 100Wh and 160Wh, approval from the airline is required. Any power banks exceeding 160Wh are strictly prohibited.

Watt-hour (Wh) ratings are the most critical factor determining international shipping restrictions for power banks. For air transport, power banks with a watt-hour rating not exceeding 100 Wh are generally permitted with fewer restrictions, often allowed in carry-on baggage on passenger flights.

How do I know if my power bank is safe?

Check Capacity: Ensure your power bank is within the allowed capacity limits (up to 100Wh for most airlines). Carry-On Only: Always pack your power bank in your carry-on luggage. Check Airline Policies: Different airlines may have specific rules, so it's best to check their website before you travel.
