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Do base stations dominate the energy consumption of the radio access network?

Furthermore,the base stations dominate the energy consumption of the radio access network. Therefore,it is reasonable to focus on the power consumption of the base stations first,while other aspects such as virtualization of compute in the 5G core or the energy consumption of user equipment should be considered at a later stage.

Should power consumption models be used in 5G networks?

This restricts the potential use of the power models, as their validity and accuracy remain unclear. Future work includes the further development of the power consumption models to form a unified evaluation framework that enables the quantification and optimization of energy consumption and energy efficiency of 5G networks.

Does 5G increase energy consumption?

However,this technological leap comes with a substantial increase in energy consumption. Compared to its predecessor,the fourth-generation (4G) network,the energy consumption of the 5G network is approximately three times higher.

Will MIMO increase the energy consumption of 5G base stations?

As a result,there are many more hardware components per base station. Björnsen believes this will probably increasethetotal energy consumption of 5G base stations compared to 4G. But as massive MIMO technology develops,its energy efficiency may also improve over time.
